March 13, 2021 Secretary's Minutes

he Alamance Region had its monthly meeting March 13th at three o'clock in the afternoon at Harbor Inn Seafood Restaurant in Burlington with approximately 28 members attending. A short business meeting was conducted by President Elizabeth Coble following an early dinner.

The Club's Memorial Plaque that is kept in the clubhouse has been updated with the names of Jane Gaither and Margot Shaw, members who passed away in 2020. O.T. Smith has been moved to the Brookdale Assisted Living/Recuperation facility on South Mebane Street in Burlington. Visitation is restricted, but O.T. would appreciate a card.

The Heat Car Club is scheduling two cruise-ins a month;

one each at Northern Tool and Holly Hill Mall. Northern Tool is located south of the interstate off Highway 62/Alamance Road and has a large parking lot. Henry Gaither will keep us informed of dates and rules of the cruise-ins.

Red Oak Brewery located on Highway 61 at I-85/40 in Whitsett is having a car show/ cruise-in April 10th at the brewery location. Herb Kluttz reported that Red Oak previously had a cruise-in and was overwhelmed by the number of cars and trucks that showed up.

The January/February issue of the NC Region News had the Alamance Region May 2020 car show Registration Form/Flyer with the May 2020 show date. The March/April issue which was recently distributed had the same flyer with a corrected May 15, 2021 show date. This date was correct for a time, but was changed at today's meeting to August 28th. The City of Burlington is not yet committing to dates for summer activities, but hopefully the August 28 schedule for our downtown car show will eventually be approved. John Cox has volunteered to obtain Trophies and Dash Plagues for the show.

Elizabeth stressed the importance of show sponsors, and we should begin immediately to contact potential sponsors for the 2021 show, regardless of when the show will occur. Saturday April 17th will be Floyd Smith's ninetieth birthday. The Club will have a hot dog and hamburger cookout celebration for Floyd at the Shiloh Presbyterian Church Scout Hut, 2638 Grand Oaks Boulevard in Burlington. More information will come later.

Henry Gaither is planning an Ice Cream run for our old cars on May 15th – details to be worked out and provided as the time gets closer.


