Jack Harris was impressed by our Clubhouse. He reported that many years ago, Judy Holmes and representatives of each chapter in the North Carolina Region, got together and made a quilt with each chapter making one square and donating \$3.25 each. The Quilt was donated back to the NC Region last year and now is displayed at the Transportation Museum in Spencer, NC. The NC Region will be having their Fall Meet at this location on September 17. Jack heads up the Finance Committee for National AACA and he reported that the loan for the New Headquarters building was paid off on February 8, 2022. He said that they will continue to raise funds for a continuing Building Fund with a goal of \$1,000,000.00.

There will be a Car Mania Event on July 24 at the New Headquarters from 8:00 am until 2:30 pm with Wayne Carini. He also addressed rumors that Hershey would be moving elsewhere. The only thing that is changing this year and going forward is to move the Flea Market to start on Monday, October 3, with set for Vendors and the Car Show moving from Saturday to Friday, October 7.

Hershey Entertainment took a big hit during Covid and they want to be able to be open every weekend during

October. Jack said that the Library Sale will be back on this year. He also said that at Charlotte Auto Fair in April, 2024, there will be a Dual Meet with the Annual Grand National Meet on Friday and the regular National Meet on Saturday. There has also been a change to the club By-Laws that will allow the Annual Meeting to move from Philadelphia each February. For 2023, the Meeting will move to Williamsburg, Virginia beginning February 10, 2023. There will be seminars, a trade show and the Awards Banquet on Saturday.

Mel Carson, a former President of AACA and a member of the Hornet's Nest Region, is working on trying to get the meeting in Charlotte, NC. Jack said that we need to be recruiting younger members to keep the club going. He said that Tom Cox and Richard Lipinello have a radio show on Saturdays at 9:00 am on America's Web Radio and everyone should try to tune in.

Otto Watson brought a copy of the Declaration of Independence and pointed out that Mask Leak, who signed next to John Hancock, is one of his relatives. Henry Gaither did an article in The Weak Spark about the Virginia Militia.

The meeting was adjourned.






