The Model S was donated to the museum by Lynn Pickett's father, and is a really interesting car. We will definitely have to schedule another visit to see it! After touring the museum, we traveled at Model A speed to Homeland Creamery in Julian for a scoop (or three!) of their delicious ice cream.






