We have submitted all of the required requests to the City of Burlington, and are scheduled to be at the City Council meeting on Feb 20 for their review of our special use permit (allowing us to close the streets). As usual, we need to mobilize our entire club membership to help sell sponsorships for the show to pay for the show, the scholarship we provide to ACC, as well as our annual operating expenses. There will be sponsor forms available at the February meeting. This is our only fundraiser for the year, so let's get started now on sponsors!

The February meeting will be held at Kimber's Steakhouse on Feb 10, from 1:00 to 3:00 pm. We had to move our meeting to an earlier time to be able to reserve a room large enough for our group! Kimber's is located at 230 W. Main St, in Gibsonville.

I will not be able to make it to Kimber's since we will be attending the AACA National Convention in Chantilly, Virginia this year. Debbie, Hannah, and I will be attending the seminars this year, and will also enjoy touring the annex of the Smithsonian Air and Space museum that is located beside Dulles airport. I'm sure we will enjoy the museum, and I always learn new stuff from the seminars! The National Convention is open to ALL AACA members, and is well worth the trip. You will get a better understanding of what the National AACA is all about, learn about the judging system, meet the AACA Library staff and the National Board members and AACA CEO Steve Moskowitz. We are fortunate that we already know the new 2024 National President, Jack Harris! The seminars are on Friday and Saturday, and you can register at the convention. If you can't make it this year, I understand it is slated to be held in Charlotte, NC next year!


