he Alamance Region Car Club met Saturday November 13, 2021 at the clubhouse for the regular monthly meeting. Attending were 39 members and no guests. The monthly December/Christmas meeting will be December 11th at the Scout Hut adjacent to Shiloh Presbyterian Church, 2638 Grand Oaks Boulevard in Burlington. Dinner will be catered and begin at 6:00 o'clock instead of our usual 6:30 meeting time.

Our Alamance Region voted to donate \$200 to the new AACA headquarters building fund at Hershey. Wallace Compton is at Liberty Commons rehabilitation facility following a fall at his home. Our best wishes for a speedy recovery for Wallace. He will appreciate a Christmas card and note.

The fee for pre-registered cars at our car shows will be \$20 beginning next year. Registration fee the day of the show will continue to be \$25. These show registration fees are more in line with what other clubs are charging.
